## **Approved BOARD MINUTES August 3, 2016**

The Village Board meeting was called to order at 8:30 am by Mayor Manicki, who led the pledge to the flag.

**PRESENT:** Mayor Manicki, Trustees: Mezydlo, Green and Daluisio, Clerk/Treasurer Wachowiak, Deputy Clerk Galbraith, Superintendent Sitzman, and Corrine Costrine.

**Absent:** Trustees Warmus

Mayor Manicki called to order a special Board Meeting to set temporary rate increase to cover cost of emergency connection to Erie County Water. Rate to revert back to original rate for water charges only, as soon as the village disconnects.

MOTION by Trustee Mezydlo and seconded by Trustee Daluisio, to approve a temporary water rate increase of .80 cents per 1,000/gallons to cover the cost of water purchased from the Erie County Water Authority. New rate will be \$4.75per 1,000 gallons. Carried.

On the question: Corrine Costrine, 1620 Lindan Ave. Friends of ours pay \$30 for 3 months and we pay \$140 for 3 months. Why don't we hook into Erie County water? Mayor Manicki: as you can see we need to increase our rate .80 cents for just 20% of water, from Erie County.

Corrine Costrine: but \$140 for 3 months?

Mayor Manicki: your bills includes water and sewer, your friends pay just for water. 2/3 of the village bill is for sewer. Erie County Water Authority charges a hydrant fee and debt service, which is billed in the taxes, so they are not seen in their water bills.
