FALL BULK TRASH COLLECTION (*All streets in village*)

Monday, Sept. 26, 2022

(Articles should not be placed at curb until pickup day)

WE CANNOT TAKE refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc. unless they have been tagged by an authorized agency that refrigerant has been removed in compliance with environmental laws.

NO Electronics

NO Tires, toxic wastes, yard wastes or construction debris

NO 1 gallon or 5-gallon cans or pails will be taken unless the tops are removed, and contents are in a non-liquid state

KEEP empty propane cylinders on separate pile from the rest of junk.

BRUSH PICK UP

All brush that can be chipped will be picked up on the following days:

YARD WASTES (grass clippings, lawn rakings, small garden plants, etc) will be picked up on Mondays until leaf collection starts. At that time, we will start pick up on a continuous rotation throughout the village. Watch your paper or call for a final collection date which will be announced toward the end of the season.

LEAVES will be picked up as soon as possible and should be placed on a pile or in a row at curbside - not in street.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICK UP: Mon, Jan. 9, Tues., Jan. 23 & Mon, Feb. 6, 2023

WASTE OIL -Village residents may dispose of used motor oil between 8:30am-4:00pm, Mon.-Fri. at the Public Works garage on Railroad Street.

ELECTRONICS- Village of Alden residents may drop off at the Public Works Garage on Railroad Street from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm Monday - Friday. Computers, monitors, printers and other computer components, fax machines, televisions, cable receivers, DVRs, DVD & VCR players. (See our website for a more complete list of acceptable items for drop off --do not put in recycle bin) **A \$5.00 per unit handling fee will apply for all televisions and computer monitors. Residents must pay this handling fee at the Village Clerk's office prior to bringing to the DPW. If you need assistance with unloading, please contact the DPW at (716) 937-7392 to make arrangements for someone to be at facility to help you.**
